## PLAYER SPECS

Before you install Desktop, please make sure your computer meets the following requirements:

- Windows 7 / Windows 8
- 4GB of RAM
- Intel i5 processor (\*or equal. The performance on computers with less powerful processors may vary depending on the multimedia assets used in applications.)

## SCREEN RESOLUTION & SCREEN ORIENTATION

Standard MultiTouch Pack applications are designed for Full HD screen resolution.

Please go to: <http://www.whatismyscreenresolution.com/> to check if your screen resolution is 1920 x 1080. If it is not, please make sure you change screen settings or use a Full HD enabled screen.

Also, note that standard MultiTouch Pack applications are designed for landscape-oriented screens only.

Applications for other screen resolutions and vertical screen orientation are available on custom basis.

## DESKTOP OR DESIGNER? WHICH DO I NEED?



### DESIGNER

**Designer** is an authoring tool that lets you build your own applications quickly without any technical background. It can be installed on any computer, wherever it is convenient for you to prepare applications. Short video tutorials for Designer are available here:

### DESKTOP

**Desktop** is used to display the applications created in Designer on a touch screen. Desktop should only be installed on the computer controlling the touch screen. Short video tutorials for Desktop are available here:

## DESKTOP CHEAT SHEET

### **CTRL+F3 - activate mouse**

Desktop is designed to be operated by touch. If your screen does not support touch input, press CTRL+F3 to activate the mouse cursor (disabled by default). If you want to switch back to touch input, just press CTRL+F3 once more.

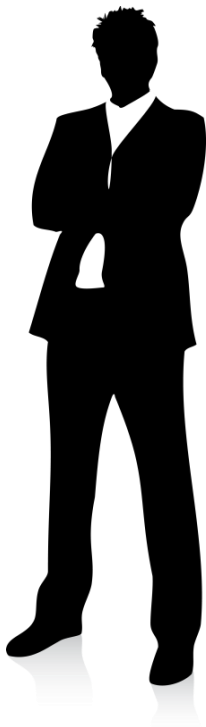
### **CTRL+A - open Desktop Manager**

Desktop Manager lets you show / hide applications and change the looks of the user interface (among other things).

Once you open Desktop you will see a PIN keypad. There is no PIN set by default, so you can press OK to continue. To set your PIN number run the "Desktop Config" shortcut file in your Desktop folder.

### **ALT+F4 - close Desktop**

Desktop is often used in public settings where you don't want end users to be able to get through to Windows. For this reason you need to use ALT+F4 to close Desktop.
